### **Profile of Speakers**



#### Shri Shaktikanta Das: Governor of Reserve Bank of India

Mr. Shaktikanta Das, Governor of Reserve Bank of India.

Retired India administrative Services (IAS). Mr. Das possesses a unique combination of experience in both policy formulation and implementation at the highest levels of state and central governments. He has served as Revenue Secretary and as Secretary, Economic Affairs, Government of India. Mr. Das has also acted as India's G20 Sherpa and Member. As Governor, Reserve Bank of India, he has spearheaded a series of measures taken by the Reserve Bank to support growth and strengthen financial stability in the country. Since the onset of COVID-19 pandemic, he has steered the Reserve Bank's response through several conventional, unconventional and innovative policy. Mr. Das was recently conferred with the 'Central Bank Governor of the Year' award by Central Banking Publication, UK in 2023.



#### Sibi George: Ambassador of India to Japan

Earlier he served as Ambassador to Switzerland, The Holy See and The Principality of Liechtenstein and Ambassador of India to Kuwait. Ambassador George joined the Indian Foreign Service in 1993. He began his diplomatic career in Cairo where he served in the Mission as Political Officer. Subsequently he moved to Indian Embassy in Doha where he handled Consular, Community, Information and Media affairs as First Secretary. Later he served as Political Counsellor in Indian High Commission in Islamabad and as Political Counsellor and Commercial Counsellor at Indian Embassy in Washington DC. He also served as Deputy Chief of Mission in Indian Missions in Tehran and Riyadh. At Headquarters of Ministry of External Affairs in New Delhi, he served in East Asia Division and also as coordinator of India - Africa Forum Summit.

He later headed Administration, Establishment and Welfare Divisions in the Ministry of External Affairs.



#### Mr. Haruhiko Kuroda: Former Governor of the Bank of Japan

Born in 1944. Graduated from the Law Faculty of The University of Tokyo and joined the Ministry of Finance in 1967. Awarded Master of Philosophy in Economics by University of Oxford in 1971, and seconded to the International Monetary Fund (IMF) in 1975-1978, acted as Director of Policy research Institute, Ministry of Finance, in 1996, Director-General of the International Bureau in 1997, Vice-Minister of Finance for International Affairs in 1999-2003. Served Special Advisor to the Cabinet while teaching as a Professor at the Graduate School of Economics, Hitotsubashi University in 2003, then President of the Asian Development Bank in 2005, and Governor of the Bank of Japan in 2013. After retiring from the Bank of Japan in 2023, took part the position of Professor of National Graduate Institute for Policy Studies.



#### Mr. Takahiro Mori: Representative Director and Executive Vice President of Nippon Steel Corporation

Born in 1957. 1983 Graduated from LL.B., Faculty of Law, The University of Tokyo. 1992 M.B.A., The Wharton School of the University of Pennsylvania.
